

# Webelos: 4<sup>th</sup> Grade



## Bobcat Badge

First badge earned by Cub Scouts of 1<sup>st</sup> grade or older. Each new Cub Scout must earn his Bobcat, even if he has never been in Cub Scouts before. The Bobcat is only earned once.



## Webelos Badge

Fourth graders work on their Webelos badge over the course of their fourth grade year. They earn it by completing 5 Required Webelos Adventures and 1 Elective Webelos Adventure.

The Cub Scout Program is designed such that each year, the Cub Scouts have Required Adventures, and a variety of Elective Adventures they can explore together.

At the Webelos level, their Den Leader is signing off on adventures, but as the parent, you can let the den leader know when something has been completed.

★ All Elective Adventures are designed to be done as a Den OR as a Family. Talk to your Den Leader about which adventures are scheduled for the next two years.

**Families are meant to be part of the FUN Cub Scouting Adventure.**

Duty to God and You Must be done with the family. This is a **required** adventure!

When an Adventure is completed (whether at home or with the den), the Den Leader notifies the Advancement Chairman of it, and the Cub Scout will receive the corresponding Adventure Pin, to be placed on his Webelos Colors, at the next Pack Meeting (normally the third Tuesday of the month). It's a great opportunity to acknowledge the hard work and effort of our Cub Scouts and give them immediate recognition.
